



COSHH STATEMENT

Megacon Group use chemicals and other hazardous substances during the course of their work. In order that employees and other people who may be affected by exposure to these substances are protected, Megacon Group will comply with the general requirements of the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 2002 (CoSHH).

We operate a strong CoSHH management system. We strive to use appropriate chemicals which are not classified as "hazardous". Where this is not possible Hazardous substances are identified and listed on a register.

A copy of the Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) will be held for every product on site which is identified as harmful. These will be obtained from the supplier or manufacturer and will be reviewed annually to ensure they remain current.

Risk assessments will be carried out annually to ensure that adequate Personal protective equipment and training are in place.

Megacon Group will ensure all products which fall into the CoSHH regime, and the processes in which they are used, are subject to assessment. Assessments will be conducted annually or when there is a significant change in manufacturing procedures.

Megacon Group will arrange for periodic inspections and maintenance of all ventilation systems used a minimum of every 14 months. The inspection and maintenance of systems will be recorded.

Staff using chemicals deemed to be hazardous will have regular health surveillance.
