



Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic (PBT) Chemicals Declaration

Megacon Controls Limited Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic (PBT) Chemicals Declaration As required under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), as amended by the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, EPA issued five final rules on January 6, 2021 to reduce exposures to certain chemicals that are persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT). These chemicals build up in the environment over time and can therefore have potential risks for exposed populations, including the general population, consumers and commercial users, and susceptible subpopulations (such as workers, subsistence fishers, tribes and children).

All five final rules take effect on February 5, 2021. These rules limit or prohibit the manufacture (including import), processing, and/or distribution in commerce (including within articles) of the following PBT chemicals:

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, Isopropylated Phosphate 3:1 (PIP 3:1)
- 2, 4, 6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2, 4, 6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

Megacon Controls Limited certifies that it is compliant with the requirements of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) regarding the five (5) Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic (PBT) chemicals listed above and that none of the aforementioned chemicals are intentionally used or added to our products.
