The Megacon Group operate a policy of continual improvement and innovation across our entire product range. We maintain an ongoing program of support and maintenance for new and legacy products, including customized and bespoke equipment.

Where an existing product or family of products is due to be phased out, it will be replaced by an equivalent item capable of being retrofitted in place of the legacy item. Proactive obsolescence management strategies operate throughout the design and production stages to, as far as is reasonably practical, mitigate against the effects of loss of availability of third party components and technologies.

Once a product or range is discontinued, Megacon will ensure legacy support is maintained for a period of a minimum of 10 years after the product has been removed from sale, except where components or materials are made unavailable for use by Megacon by external factors or legislation.
